RULES OF PLAY

- USGA Rules govern all play except where modified by local rules.
- Out-of-Bounds is defined by walls, fences, curbs and white stakes. A ball that crosses a public road defined as out of bounds and comes to rest beyond that road is out of bounds, even though it may lie on another part of the course.
- Flower beds (not including rancho landscaping) are considered to be ground under repair. Play is prohibited from all flower beds. Flower beds surrounded by a cart path are considered part of the obstruction.
- Rancho areas are a playable part of the course. You do not receive relief. Please do not drive your cart into these areas.
- Golf Course Ambassadors are to assist all players in finishing their round in less than 4 hours and 15 minutes. They may ask your group for special assistance if you are behind that pace.

GOLF AT THE WIGWAM IS A TRULY CLASSIC EXPERIENCE.

Once known as the Red Course and so named for its designer, Robert "Red" Lawrence, the par-72, 6,900-yard course is a natural complement to the Gold and Patriot. Set among a forest of pines and eucalyptus, this 224-acre, parkland course plays alongside and over ponds, streams and canals and will test even the most experienced player with its final four holes. The par-5 18th weaves along a canal, then between two ponds and over another canal, all before leaving the golfer with a substantial approach shot to a large, undulated green. The Heritage stands in tribute to the men and women who have shaped the history of Arizona over the past 100 years.
